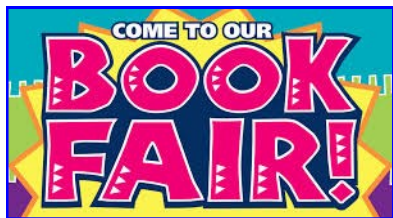
Book Fair
