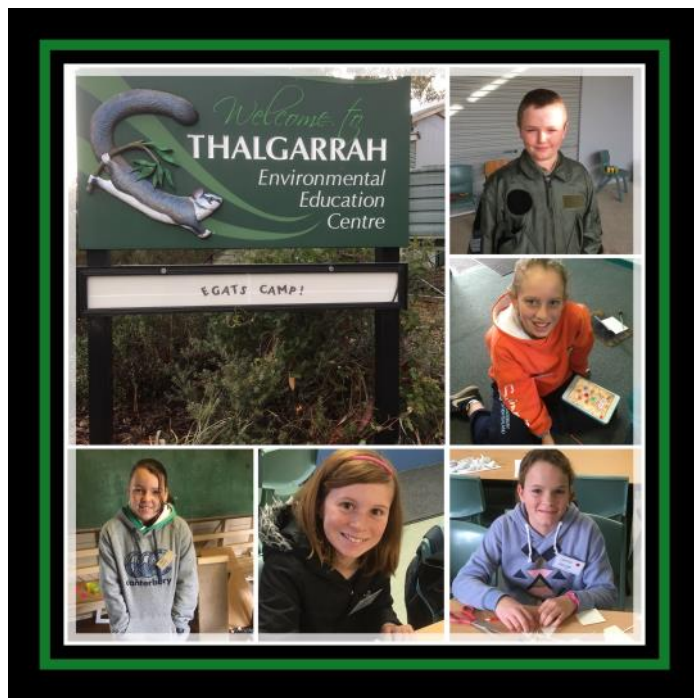
eGATS Camp

This week the students participated in a PBL lesson that reminded them of the behaviour expectations before, during and after receiving awards at assemblies.

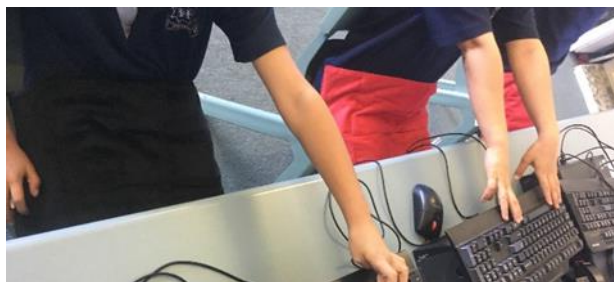
