PBL Term 3 Week 3

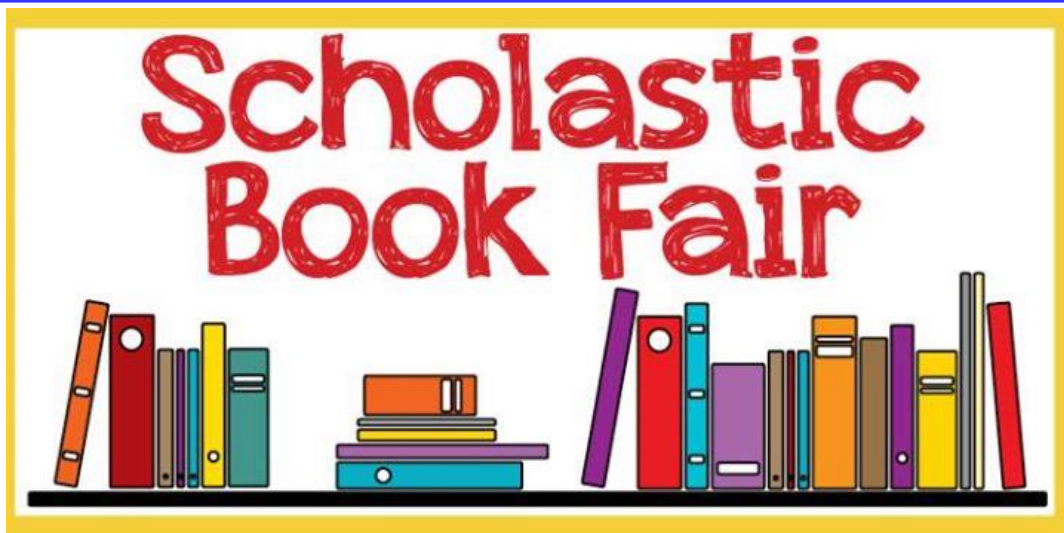
