The drought continues to ravage our community. I know that the holiday period held many difficult times for our community and families with more fires. The water situation affecting our town has continued to challenge each of our households and businesses. The NSW Department of Education has remained incredibly supportive, adaptable and flexible with the challenges we are facing. Our students will continue to be supplied with drinking water as required. The DoE is covering the costs of our daily drinking water.

We appreciate families who are sending children with their own water bottles each day, with water from home that has been purchased or previously boiled. No student in our school will go without water and each classroom teacher has access to drinking water for their students as required each day.

Can we please ask that all student water bottles, and all other school property—uniforms etc, continue to be checked for labels, as items without

names will be thrown out or left in lost property until disposed of.

Kindergarten transition for next year has begun! We are accepting kindergarten enrolments for next year. All new students have an enrolment meeting first, so lock in a time with the ladies in the front office for this.

ROAD SAFETY

Until your child/ren is at least 10 years old, they should ride off-road away from vehicles and driveways.

While your child/ren may learn skills such as balancing, pedalling and steering quite easily, they are still learning skills that help them to judge speed, distance and the direction of sound. Your young child/ren will often ride with their head down, concentrating on pedalling, not the environment around them. Your child needs ongoing adult help in safe, off-road locations to gradually develop all their skills.

We remind ourselves and each other to always meet our three core values of learning, safety and respect every day.

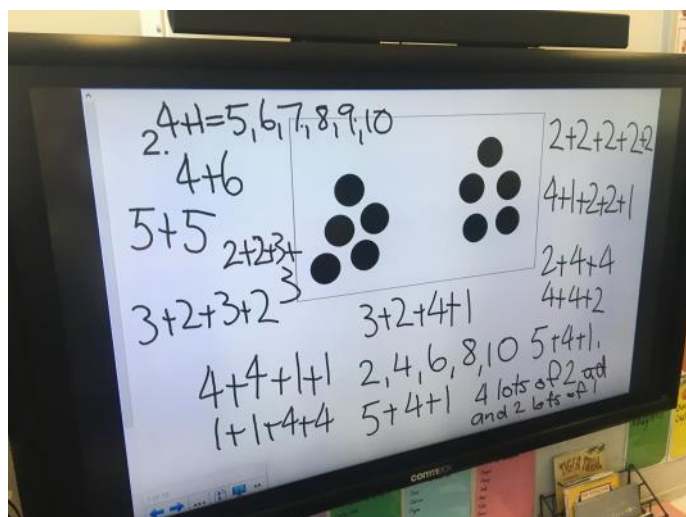
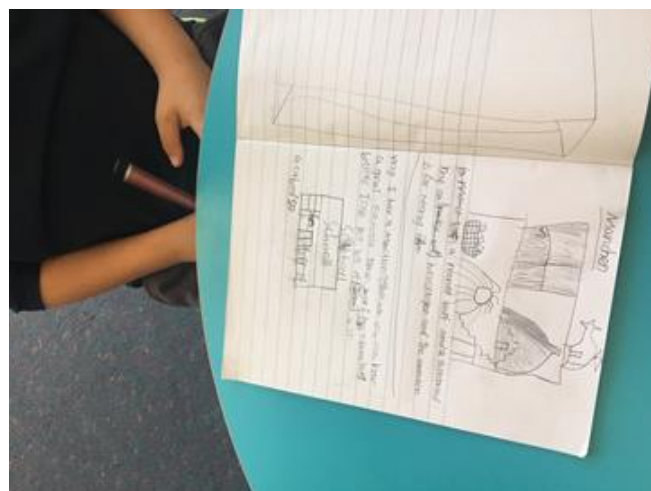
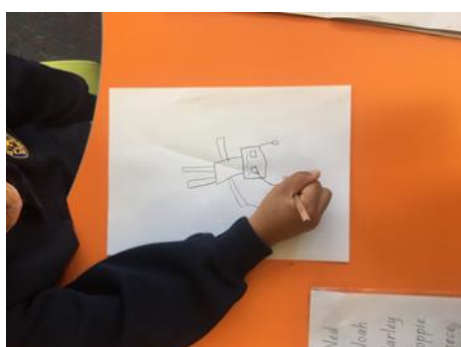
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Bigibilas Newsletter Report
