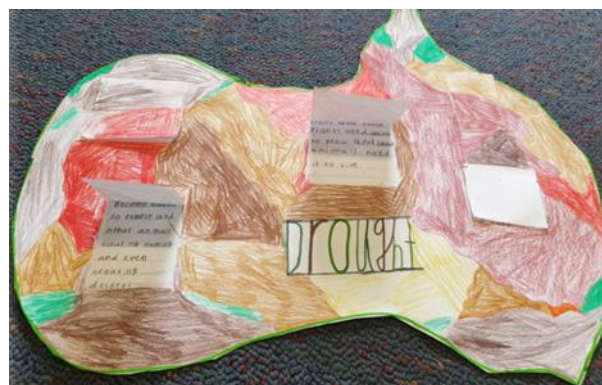
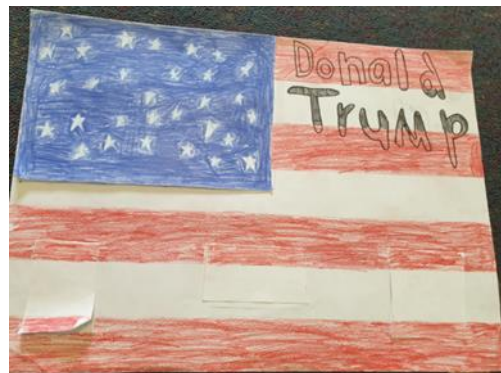

Henrys says put your rubbish in the bin.

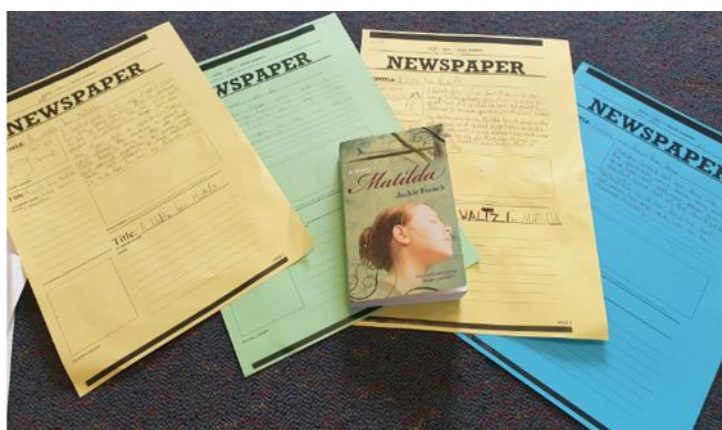

Term 4 in the Yurrandaalis Classroom

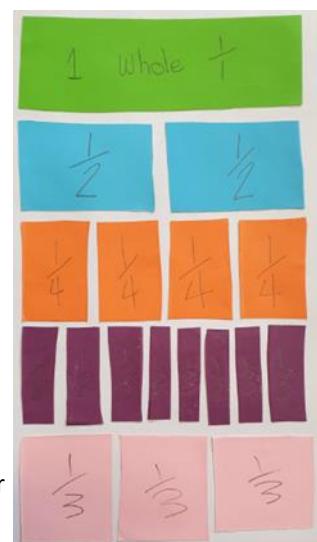
