PBL Term 2 Week 8

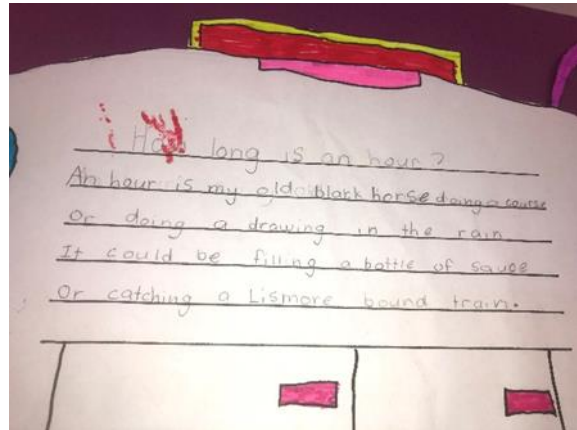
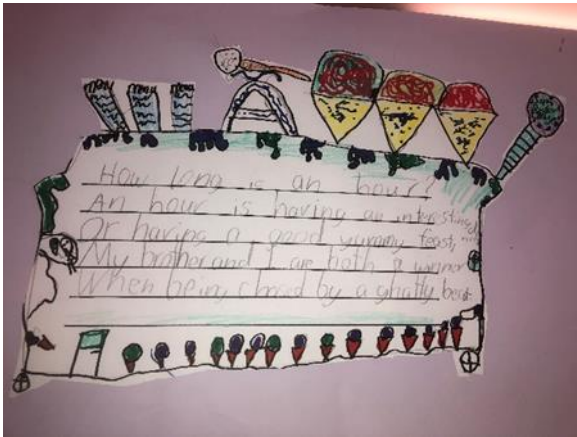
