Term 4 is flying by so very quickly. Please keep an eye on our calendar, which has all the dates set for end of year activities. Presentation Day, at this stage, will be virtual. This will all depend on whether or not we are still on Level 3 restrictions—which state no parents or visitors on site.

We continue to remain on Level 3 restrictions. From Monday 18th October 2021, all visitors, contractors and staff can use School Visitor Check-in to sign-in at their school. The new QR codes replace all existing COVID-safe QR codes and will be located at the front office area to ensure visitors and contractors who attend the school during school hours report to the front office reception area. Parents and carers will not be required to check-in for drop off or pick up.

Current cleaning regimes will continue on school sites. Target areas include high-touch areas and other hard surfaces, door handles, lockers, light switches and handrails in stairways and movement areas. Enhanced cleaning is delivered as part of the daily cleaning of schools. Well ventilated spaces reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19. Our staff ensure each day that their classrooms are well ventilated.

Thank you to our fantastic teaching, non teaching and office staff—who have all settled back into our routines each day, albeit with the restrictions that continue to remain in place. Our students are so very lucky to have continuity with their learning, compared to the staggered returns in Sydney and surrounds. If you would like to meet with your child's class teacher to discuss progress, or if you have any concerns, please contact the front office to book in a meeting time.

We are finalising our classes for 2022 at the moment. We would love to have all of our Kinder 2022 enrolments processed and ready to begin for Day 1, 2022. If you have not enrolled your child or have any questions, please call. We are here and ready to answer any questions.


