This week we will have our week 6 assembly. Hopefully all students are still displaying our school values of Learning, Safety and Respect and earning their next level of reward

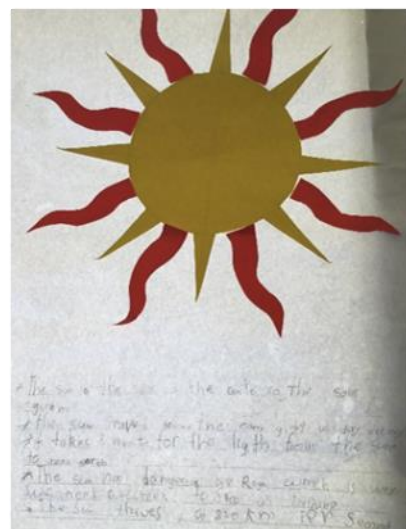
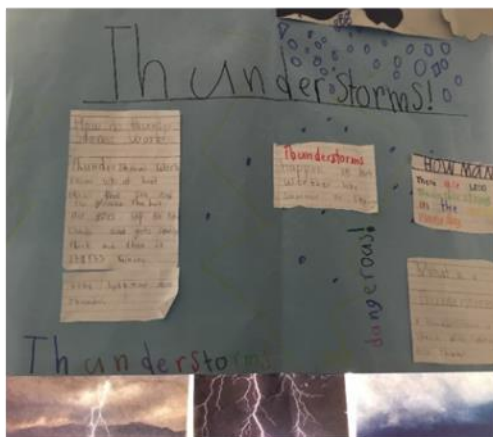
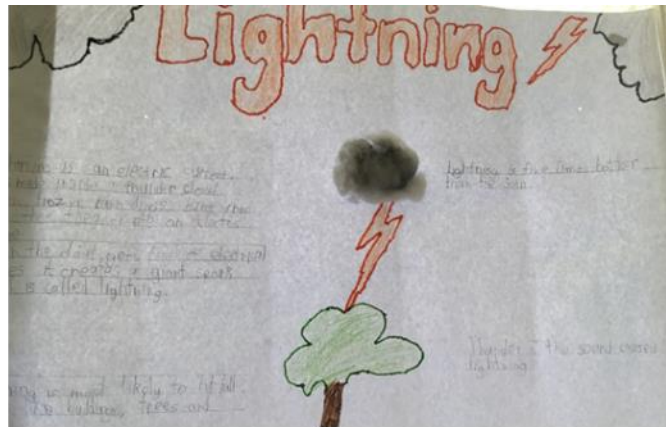
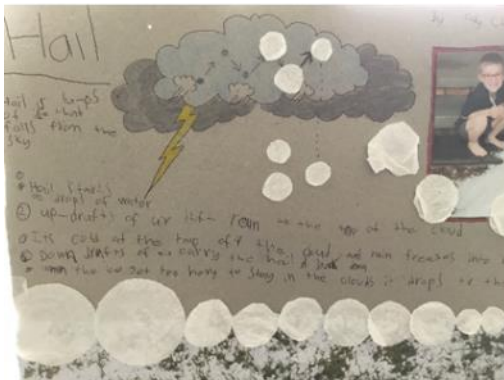
